Details for the funeral of Peter Keenan – Friday 25th Jan

Ceremony: 12 noon at St Peter's Church, Gloucester St, Winchcombe, GL54 5LU

Parking in Winchcombe can be difficult when it's busy, so leave a bit of time to find a parking space. There are 3 main car parks:

- 1. Back Lane Car Park, Back Lane, Winchcombe, GL54 5PZ is the biggest with space for 98 cars. Parking costs £1 for the day. Entrance is from Back lane, turning down by the library. To get to the church, walk out the back of the car park onto Cowl Lane and turn right to walk a short way through the middle of the village onto Gloucester St. Turn right, the church is 50 yards on your right handside.
- 2. Bull Lane Car Park, Bull Lane, Winchcombe, GL54 5HX is the second biggest with space for 41 cars. Parking costs £2 for 3 hours. Turn down Chandos St from either North St or Hailes St to access Bull Lane. Walk back into the centre of the village, turning right onto Gloucester St, the church is 100 yards on your right handside.
- 3. Abbey Terrace, Winchcombe, GL54 5LL is the smallest and nearest to the church and is free for 2 hours. Spaces here are relatively rare. The church is 20 yards from here going away from the centre of the village.
- 4. If these are all full, there can be roadside spaces available on Back Lane and Vinyard St if you go down far enough towards Sudeley Castle. Otherwise you may have to park some distance away and walk, which is not ideal if you're running late!

The church will be open from 11.30, with the ceremony scheduled to start at 12 noon prompt.



No flowers thank you, there will be flowers and greenery from Peter's garden. However, donations for Peter's Solar Aid project in the Zambia, will be gratefully received. The project is something he had been working on with the Rotary Club of Cheltenham North for several years, which has so far enabled a considerable number of hospitals, schools and homes in Zambia to have their first ever access to electric light. The lights are all powered by the sun and Peter felt passionately about bringing light to as many places as he could. Peter will be buried at a Private Ceremony directly after the St Peter's Church Service ends at around 1pm. Janet, Caroline, Philip, Robbie, Barry and the grandchildren will therefore arrive at The Wake a short while after everyone else.

The Wake: The Clubhouse, Bugatti Owner's Club, Prescott Hill, Gotherington, GL52 9RD.

The wake will be held immediately after the Ceremony and is intended to be a celebration of Peter's life. Food and drink will be served and you are free to wander round and look at the race track if the weather permits and you so wish.

You will need to go back to your car as it is a 10 min drive away. Look for signs saying "Prescott Speed Hill Climb" and you will know you are there. When you reach Prescott turn in and then shortly afterwards turn left. The Clubhouse is the furthest building up on the hill. Head for the upper car park at the top which is just above the Clubhouse. There will be signs directing you as to where to park. There is parking/drop off for <u>disabled only</u> immediately in front of the clubhouse. Peter's Bentley will also be there. Parking is free and in plentiful supply.
