### Personal Injury

### Inquests

Chloe has considerable experience in Coroners' law and inquests and accepts instructions on domestic and Article 2 inquests.

She was instructed by the Senior Coroner of Manchester as junior counsel to the inquest, led by Marc Willems QC, in the Inquest into the death of Jordan Begley in 2015 (<http://www.bbc.co.uk/news/uk-england-manchester-33373531>). The inquest involved a number of interested persons including Greater Manchester Police, the IPCC and Taser International. The inquest was complex and lasted for several weeks.

More recently Chloe was instructed by one of the main interested persons in the Inquest into the death of Stephen Hunt, a firefighter who

died during active service (<http://www.bbc.co.uk/news/uk-england-manchester-36323367>). The inquest lasted 6 weeks and heard evidence from more than 80 witnesses including expert witnesses dealing with the cause, location and spread of fire.

## Other

As is typical of Chambers, Chloe adopts an informal approach to her practice and is happy to talk through cases and issues with solicitors before receipt of any formal instructions.
